## **AMENDMENT TO:**

MANDATE TO EOTA  
CONCERNING THE EXECUTION OF HARMONISATION WORK  
FOR AN ETA GUIDELINE ON

**COLD STORAGE ROOM KITS**

### **Explanatory note**

This proposed amendment follows from a request from the EOTA Working Group during the preparation of the work programme to answer to the mandate for the preparation of a guideline for European technical approvals on “Cold storage room kits” (CONSTRUCT 01/506).

The proposed amendment is based on the existence of a French decree dealing with the resistance to the seismic actions and on the need of making reference in a more precise way to the foodstuffs directives in the footnote in Annex 2 of the mandate.

### **This amendment modifies the original mandate in the following manner:**

The text of Annex 2 of the mandate to EOTA on **COLD STORAGE ROOM KITS** shall be modified as indicated in Annex A of this amendment.

## ANNEX A

### **Introduction:**

The table in of Annex 2 of the original mandate needs to be amended to include as follows

### **AMENDMENT TO ANNEX 2 OF MANDATE**

*The following replaces the table given in Annex 2 of the Mandate given to EOTA under the title “Cools storage room kits”:*

The characteristics to be covered by the ETA Guideline\* will be:

E R	PERFORMANCE CHARACTERISTIC	Durability
2	- Reaction to fire - Resistance to fire	Y
3	- Vapour permeability - Moisture resistance - Release of dangerous substances	
4	- Mechanical resistance - Slipperiness (floors) - Impact resistance - Resistance to eccentric loads (fixtures) - Safety against personal injury - Safety against collapse due to air pressure differences - Safety against entrapment - Resistance to seismic actions	
6	- Thermal resistance - Air permeability	

\* Depending on their intended use, cold storage room kits may (in addition to the above) have to comply with the requirements of the Council Directive 93/34/EEC related to “Foodstuffs” and Council Directive 89/109/EEC and related specific directives, related to “Food contact materials”.
