



ADDENDUM TO:

MANDATE TO CEN/CENELEC
CONCERNING THE EXECUTION OF STANDARDISATION WORK
FOR HARMONISED STANDARDS ON

M116 - MASONRY AND RELATED PRODUCTS

This addendum modifies the original mandate in the following manner:

- The product families “masonry units”, “factory-made masonry mortars” and “factory-made rendering/plastering mortars” shall be added to table 3/3 in Annex 3 of the mandate on **MASONRY AND RELATED PRODUCTS**, such that it shall read as shown in Annex A below.
- This is to cover mortars for which the intended use in wall and partitions is subject to reaction to fire regulations.
- The corresponding Commission Decision 97/740/EC will be amended accordingly.
